## Minutes of the November 9, 2023 Council 9667 Meeting

GK Greg Ullman was unable to attend the meeting, so Brother Jonathan O'Connor, PGK served as Acting Grand Knight. The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:07 pm with 19 members in attendance.

The Acting GK led us in reciting the Opening Prayer, Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be. The Warden led in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, the Council sang the Opening Ode.

The roll call indicated that all officers were present or accounted for. Dignitaries present were acknowledged.

As the minutes of the previous meeting were published in the Council Newsletter, a motion was made and seconded to dispense with their reading. The motion passed unanimously. One correction was made to the minutes as they did not mention a Parish Breakfast in December. It WILL be held on December 17th.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the previous meetings minutes, as amended. The motion passed unanimously.

Chaplain's Message: Our Chaplain, Fr. Joseph, is excused since he is on a trip to Italy from Nov 5th to Nov 22nd.

## Grand Knight Report:

- Our Parish Breakfast this month will be held Sunday, November 26th after the 8:00am and 9:30am Masses. The October breakfast was successful with about 110 attendees. We will start meal prep at 6:00am and can always use help, so please join us if you can even if it's for a short time.
- Although the November bulletin you just received didn't include a parish breakfast on the December calendar, we are planning to put on a breakfast after the 8:00am and 9:30am Masses on December 17th,
- Mark your calendar, next month we have our Council business meeting on December 14th, and we are exploring two alternatives for a special Good of the Order on a different day, not after the meeting.

One possibility is for the Knight's to go out for dinner at Silky Sullivan's in the Derby Room on

Tuesday, December 12th at 6:30pm. This would be our Christmas gathering for the Holidays.

The other possibility is to put on our own Christmas dinner; please see Troy Nguyen after this council meeting to help in planning it. Troy thinks he can cook prime rib, mashed potatoes, veggie and salad for \$30 per person, either as a parish fundraiser or just the council. The Knights' Ladies are unavailable to decorate or purchase anything on short notice, so the Knights would have to do the entire setup. We have already reserved the Hall for a Christmas dinner on Saturday, December 9 at 5:00 pm, but we might be able to change to December 16, if needed.

- 3. At the last Chapter meeting, October 26th, they reported expenses for the Orange County Walk for Life was approximately \$10,000, which included serving 1800 hamburger meals and social media production. They requested that the councils send an optional reimbursement, and we sent the \$250 recommended amount. There will be no Chapter meetings in November and December.

- A lecture by Doctor of Philosophy Pablo Munoz Iturrieta and Fr. Alan Berender on "Rescuing Family's Original Plan" at La Purisima Catholic Church in Orange on Friday, November 17th at 6pm for parents, and Saturday November 18th from 11:30am to 2:00pm for youth.

The Acting GK led the closing prayer for Blessed Fr. McGivney, Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be.


After Closing Prayer, Council sang the Closing Ode.
