- 1. Chapter Information
- The Walk for Life at Christ Cathedral was last Saturday, October 7. Our council did not form a carpool to the event and nobody from our council was able to attend to help. According to the Christ Cathedral Facebook page, thousands of people attended the event. The Southern California Chapter approved a motion to give \$8,000 to cover expenses for the Walk for Life. This included renting chairs and food for the participants. Councils were encouraged to contribute to offset the Chapter's expenses. I have been advised that our council can contribute the suggested \$250 donation without a vote from the members; therefore, since this is the least we can do to support this successful event I approved the expenditure.
- The Chapter approved a motion to donate \$4,500 to Supreme's Hawaii Relief Fund. This is in addition to the \$500 they approved at the last meeting.


