Minutes of the September 14, 2023 Council 9667 Meeting

GK Greg Ullman called the meeting to order at approximately 7:00 pm with 18 members in attendance.

The GK led us in reciting the Opening Prayer, Our Father, and the Acting Warden led the Pledge of Allegiance. After, the Council sang the Opening Ode.

The roll call indicated that all officers were present or accounted for. Dignitaries present were acknowledged.

As the minutes of the previous meeting were published in the bulletin, a motion was made and seconded to dispense with their reading. The motion passed unanimously.

Chaplain's Message: None

Grand Knight Report:

- 1. We received a letter from Mary's Path in Santa Ana thanking the council for our \$1,000 donation. (They serve pregnant and parenting teen mothers in foster care.)
- 2. I want to thank those who helped with the parish picnic in the rain on August 20th.
- 3. We will prepare a parish breakfast Sunday, September 24th after the 8:00am and 9:30am Masses. We will be a little short on staff since at least five of the regular crew will be out of town, but Bro. John Arnold will be able to lead the cooking, so if you have wanted to help us prepare or serve breakfast, this is a good month to start.
- 4. There is a Fourth Degree Exemplification ceremony on Saturday, September 30th for those who want to become a full Knight. Unfortunately, the one candidate from our council postponed his participation so it appears we will not have a candidate this time.
- 5. Orange County Chapter Meeting Notes:
- The Orange Walk for Life at Christ Cathedral is less than a month from now, on Saturday, October 7th, starting at 8:30am. This will include an international rosary, speeches on the dignity of life, a Mass and procession. The Orange County Chapter has assigned duties to

all of the councils: first, they are asking each council to gather at least 60 people from each parish and organize transportation for them by bus or in carpools of 4 or more. This is necessary since those are the only vehicles that will be allowed to park on the Cathedral grounds. Cars with fewer than 4 people will have to remote park across Lewis Street toward Orangewood Avenue. Second, they are asking each council to have 10 brother Knights, with their badges, volunteer at the event. Our council, along with a few other councils, are assigned to be Ushers and Procession Guides.

- The Southern California Chapter agreed to donate \$5000 in support of those in need due to the Maui fires. On-account-of Chapter rules, they could only approve a maximum (\$500) at the meeting. They will vote and approve the remaining \$4,500 at their next meeting on September 28th. Other Chapters and councils are making their own donations.
- The Diocese of Orange and Knights of Columbus are hosting the annual Walk for Life on Oct 7th on the Christ Cathedral campus. In support of the cost, the Chapter will vote on a financial advance of \$7500 at their next meeting. They are requesting these costs be offset by council donations as well.
- The next Chapter meeting will be September 28th at Our Lady Queen of Angeles parish at 2046 Mar Vista Dr in Newport Beach.
