The meeting of K of C Council 9667 on Tuesday, August 8, 2017, was called to order by GK Damon Ferrara at approximately 7:10 PM with about 30 council members present saying the Our Father, singing the opening ode and reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to our flag.

The roll call indicated that all officers were present or accounted for except for the Chaplain, Deputy Grand Knight, and Outside Guard who were excused. Dignitaries present were acknowledged. New member, Danny Gutierrez, was acknowledged and welcomed.
