Do you have a "Third Place"? The oldest generation remembers a time when, in addition to their home and work, people had a third place they could go, without cost or responsibilities, where they can relax and chat with others in their community, including a core group of regulars that are often seen there. Several authors and online discussions have discussed the social effects of the decline in availability of Third Places during the past few decades.

The pubs where folks could spend an afternoon chatting with neighbors and playing darts have been replaced by restaurants that urge you to leave when you are done eating to make room for the next group. Those who used to spend the day in a library or bookstore now go there only to quickly pick up a book they need, since they get their information and entertainment online. Most community clubs and organizations used to have their own meeting halls that were open for hours after a meeting, but most, like our own council, now have to share or rent a room for their meetings.

Fortunately, Holy Spirit Church still fills the role of a Third Place as it is constantly busy with social and spiritual meetings every evening and weekend, and Council 9667 provides its share of activities each month, if you just participate. And don't be in such a hurry to leave; stay and chat for a while after a meeting, meal or volunteering. Arrange to stay a bit longer than the half-hour Council business meeting when we provide an additional social activity. We would like to hear your ideas about lectures, games or other interests that you want to share in with your brother Knights on meeting nights.


The GK led the closing prayer for Blessed Michael McGivney, followed by the Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be.
